- 1. Busy year with contaminated soils jobs, 40,000-50,000 tonnes.
- 2. Sending fluorescent bulbs offsite for recycling. Previously crushed bulbs onsite. Removes safety risks by shipping off site.
- 3. Frost protection in new cell now in place, 1 meter of garbage acts as insulator to clay liner. Litter fencing installed on south side of new cell.
- 4. Hydrovac slurry pad proposal has been finalized and submitted Alberta Environment & Parks.
- 5. Working with U of C professors on alternatives for biocap grant funding.
- 6. Joe reaching out to municipalities in the region to implement a regional disaster debris management plan based on his master's thesis. Has been asked to speak at various conferences.
- 7. U of C students working on a storm water report for the site. May need to build a berm in the SE corner to contain water after heavy rain or run off.
- 8. Rocky Mountain Equipment ordered the wrong tracks for the dozer. Offer to sell 28" track pads for \$9,300.00. Regular price is \$18,718.36. Could be stored in the equipment tent until needed.
