Positive results from Leduc biocap thus far. AEP submission on the hydrovac pad has been submitted and will go out for public notification in early March. Presenting thesis findings at the CARE conference on Thursday in High River. Storm water report from U of C students should be finalized by April and ready for submission to AEP for summer construction of a berm. Grant application submitted to Efficiency Alberta for \$75,000 feasibility study on renewable energy. Styrofoam recycler hasn't been taking material for over a month.
