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Operations Update: Joe Angevine

- 1. RSWMP draft report unavailable. Paul is working with GHD to correct inaccuracies in the report. The new draft will be available in September, with presentations to member Councils to follow.
- 2. Finalizing Biocover documents. Still waiting on funding. Regardless of funding, the capping is necessary.
- 3. Concrete crushing complete. County grader fixed roads with crushed material.
- 4. Still waiting on Hydrovac pad approval, AEP assigned a different caseworker to the file. Foothills County has taken steps to address traffic concerns.
- 5. Working with regional municipalities on Regional Disaster Debris Management Plan to be better prepared for the aftermath of a disaster.
- 6. AEP made a site visit, no issues with the berm proposal in the SE corner of the site. Floating pump station working well, good results from water sampling.
- 7. Leachate collection system flushed last week, two collection lines flushed. Scaling and sediment minimal, no major blockages.
- 8. Sampling of old stockpiles of soil from 20 plus years ago. Need to start moving the soil for future cell construction. Working with engineers on long term planning for access to cells in the future.
- 9. Sprayed noxious weeds twice this year. Ongoing battle on site.
- 10. Extended fall hours for residential loads begins on September 9 October 10, 2019. Advertised on website and newspaper.
- 11. Household Hazardous Waste round ups at the Priddis & Black Diamond transfer sites on September 28, 2019.
