Operations Update: Joe Angevine

- 1. Landfill was closed last Friday due to high winds, a lot of clean up to be done on site. Winds reached 90 km/hr.
- 2. Leachate collection system has a blockage on south end of site. Actively pumping leachate past the blockage so camera can reach
- 3. Wood grind is complete. Chip is being hauled offsite to feedlots.
  4. Hydrovac update AEP has responded and asked us to contact the concerned residents to rectify any other concerns.
- 5. Household Hazardous Waste round ups held on September 28th at the Black Diamond/Turner Valley & Priddis transfer stations. Weather was bad but round up collected a lot of material.
- 6. Fall extended hours finished up, not heavily utilized this year due to poor weather.
- 7. Terrapin floating wetlands will remove 90 wetlands in the spring.
- 8. Upcoming budget discussion.
