Frank Lake Lift Station/Pipeline Update: Harry Riva Cambrin:

Analysis of the future of the Frank Lake Lift Station Pipeline determined that the pipeline is at full capacity. If Cargill were to increase their water usage, and the Town of High River were to expand, the pipeline would require improvements to sustain the growth. The Town of High River is looking at building a new treatment plant and reducing their water intake, whereas Cargill is inquiring into increasing their water intake. The commission for Frank Lake clarified that the users of the pipeline pay for the costs associated with the pipeline. Alberta Environment has assessed Frank Lake and determined that the treatment process requires improvement. Harry Riva Cambrin suggested reaching out to university students to see if they would be interested in analyzing/researching Frank Lake. Chair Delilah Miller suggested inquiring for grants for Frank Lake/pipeline improvements. Mr. Riva Cambrin attended a Highwood Management Plan meeting and stated that he will distribute the presentation for the benefit of the Waste Water Operations committee.
