#### 4. BUSINESS

4.1 Matters arising from the previous minutes

ACTION: P. Lyons will collaborate with J. Angevine and H. Riva Cambrin on advertising to help people understand what is considered hazardous waste and what isn't.

Completed: No.

- 4.2 Foothills Regional Landfill & Resource Recover Centre (LRRC) update
  - Finalizing the bio-cover design for installation this year.
  - Hydroac pad is currently receiving two or three loads per day.
  - Closed on Saturday, December 24<sup>th</sup> and Monday, December 26<sup>th</sup> and will reopen on Tuesday, December 27<sup>th</sup> for normal hours.
  - A new landfill cell will be started next year, the current cell is four years old.
  - No waste audits have been done at the landfill.

ACTION: Municipalities will send J. Angevine a copy of their most recent waste audits.

#### 4.3 Municipal program updates

- 4.3.1 Black Diamond
  - Blue recycling carts were delivered to residents the week of May
    2nd
  - Green organic carts will be delivered to residents the week of May 16<sup>th</sup>.
- 4.3.2 High River
  - All garbage trucks are now operational.
  - Trucks are sanitized every day as part of the safety protocol.

ACTION: P. Lyons will send information to the group on the sanitizing machine Okotoks purchased for its vehicles.

#### 4.3.3 Okotoks

- Assisting Black Diamond and Turner Valley with their threestream collection rollout, including public engagement sessions at AG Foods, Rona, Sheep River Library and the Oilfields high school.
- Took possession of a new garbage truck.
- Working with Lateral Innovations on upgrades to the cart management software. The current system on the collection trucks will transition to an android system with a turn by turn feature within the next year.
- Since the Foothills LRRC is closed on statutory holidays, arrangements have been made with the City of Calgary to dispose of garbage from Black Diamond, Okotoks and Turner Valley.
- Toured the Executive Mat facility to view a closed loop organic waste management system.
- Attending Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) meetings for information on how it will affect the Town and region.

## 4.3.5 Turner Valley

- Black garbage carts have been distributed to residents.
- Green organic carts will be delivered to residents the week of May 9<sup>th</sup>. A kitchen catcher including a brochure and a sample compostable bag will be attached to each green cart.
- Oilfield Recycling Centre will cease to operate as of Saturday, June 25<sup>th</sup>. Staff and residents have been notified.
- Council eliminated the annual spring clean-up program.
- T. Dougall left the meeting at 11:13 a.m.
- 4.4 Recycling Compact Florescent Lightbulbs (CFL)
  - J. Angevine provided an update on the new local option for recycling Compact Fluorescent bulbs/Lamps at the LRRC. This option is a third of the cost of the previous option. A test on the crushed glass did not reveal any mercury, allowing it to be disposed of in the landfill.

## 4.5 Regional Collaboration

With the closure of the Oilfields Recycling Centre there will no longer be a place for residents to dispose of electronic waste or glass locally.

ACTION: J. Angevine will speak to Foothills County regarding electronic waste collection at the transfer site.

ACTION: C. Beaton will provide J. Angevine with information on the company that currently collects electronic waste at the Oilfields Recycling Centre.
